TRAVEL & PARKING

When arriving at camp, come from the East along 16th Avenue. Do not come from the West and make an illegal left turn in to camp. This is for your safety and other drivers.

There is no charter bus available. Translink bus #563 comes as far south as 20th Avenue along 200th Street. Please visit www.translink.ca for more information.

Participants will be directed to park. Please follow the instructions given. Due to the number of vehicles and trailers expected, groups are requested to park where they will remain for the weekend.

There are no in and out privileges. If you need to leave camp for whatever reason, please report to registration; if registration is closed, report to the Rotary building.

REGISTRATION

Upon arrival, <u>ALL</u> participants must report to the registration both near the Erickson building; this includes groups arriving together, individual participants looking for their groups, and day visitors.

Register by Jan 15th \$30 – After Jan 15th \$35

Registration includes one badge. Extra badges are available for \$2.

All participants must be fully registered members of Scouts Canada or Girl Guides of Canada and come to camp with proof of registration. Not having proof of registration means you may not be able to stay. We do not have the staff available to look you up online or wait for you to (it will be busy).

When submitting your registration form you must include:

- A list of participants from MyScouts or IMIS.
- A copy of medical forms for each participant (this will be kept by First-Aid/MAST and either returned to each Group or shredded after camp). If registering



online, you can bring this with you to camp and hand it at registration upon arrival.

There will be no Cold Talk prior to camp this year, as the location has changed to a warmer climate. A Cold Talk may be offered at camp to prepare participants for what's in store in 2023!

EXPECTATIONS

Water – May not be available on site. Campers should come with water for their personal use.

Washrooms – The girls washroom near Rotary will be open; everyone can use the porta-potties which are setup throughout the camp.

Facilities – Indoor access is restricted to staff – this is a great year to test out any new shelters and equipment!

Cabins – These are off-limits. Participants are expected to sleep in tents or temporary shelters.

Swain Shelter & Field – This area is off-limits.

Butcher Shelter – This is for everyone to use. No one group should claim this as their own. Sharing, sharing!

Weather – Though camp is being held in the Fraser Valley, be prepared for wet and cold weather.

RISK MANAGEMENT

First-Aid/MAST — Will be located near the First-Aid hut, next to the Rotary building. Boundaries — Participants must remain on Camp McLean property for the weekend. There are no in and out privileges except for emergencies or someone is planning to sign out of camp early. Groups are asked not to leave the property without first checking with staff (this includes hiking in the Campbell River Valley Regional Park). We need to ensure participants are safe, this includes knowing where you are.

Reportable Incidents – Please ensure any reportable incident is brought to the attention of camp staff; any health-related incidents should be reported to First-Aid/MAST.

Medical Facility – The nearest facility is the Langley Memorial Hospital located at 22051 Fraser Hwy, Langley, B.C. *Directions: Head east along 16th Avenue, turn left*



on 216th Street (heading north), turn right on 48th Avenue, turn left on 222nd Street, turn left on Fraser Hwy and you should see the Hospital to your right.

Muster Point / Camp-wide Emergency – In case of a camp wide emergency, all participants are asked to meet at the front field near the totem poles (stay off the road).

Physical Fitness / Personal Health Form — Each member is expected to have on their person a completed form. If someone is found unconscious, this form could help them receive treatment quickly.

Behavior – You will be asked to leave camp if found not to be following SC or GGC rules and regulations, or if involved in an activity that puts yourself or others at risk.

Missing Member – Please advise the First-Aid/MAST and staff teams ASAP.

RULES & REGULATIONS

Rules – Scouts Canada members are expected to follow all bylaws, policies, and procedures. Girl Guides of Canada members are expected to follow all applicable rules and regulations.

Restricted Activities – While included in the rules above: smoking, vaping, use of drugs (except those prescribed to the user which are not otherwise restricted by Scouts Canada – prescription labels should be clear and contain the users name), alcohol or any other intoxicating substances are strictly prohibited. Weapons of any kind are not permitted except for knives or other tools where permissible by SC or GGC rules and regulations. Fireworks, flares, or other explosives are not permitted.

Parking – Once a car is parked, it should remain where it is for the weekend. **Generators** – Not permitted.

Accommodations – Sleeping in vehicles is not permitted. Participants are expected to sleep in tents or temporary shelters.

Campfires – Wood burning campfires should be in designated firepits. Propane firepits are welcome.

Leave No-Trace – We practice LNT. Pack out what you pack in. Groups are expected to clean their camping area before receiving their badges and receipts at the end of camp.



COVID/PANDEMIC PROTOCOLS

When planning, please consult Scouts Canada's pandemic stage requirements in effect at the time of camp. As of the publication of this registration package (November 30, 2021), the Fraser Valley Council is in stage 4 (as well as surrounding councils). Please consider that any standards published by Scouts Canada will supersede any requirements included in this package, and any standards published by the Government of British Columbia will supersede all other requirements. Please familiarize yourself with the rules in effect at the time of camp.

Masks are not mandated while outdoors, however staff may require masks be worn for certain activities where participants from different groups may come in to close contact. Please look for signs posted where masks may be required. Masks are required when entering any indoor facility including the girl's washroom.

All participants are required to be vaccinated unless an exemption has been granted and your continued participation in in-person activities has been agreed by Scouts Canada.
